Street Parking Restrictions

The NO PARKING signs are now up on the South end of Sunflower Drive. This helps ensure that emergency vehicles can get to all residents. There are about 400 of these NO PARKING areas in Bloomington. According to the Bloomington Municipal Code 15.32.080, the cul-de-sacs are included in the NO PARKING areas. This will come as a surprise to many of our friends and other visitors. Please help them avoid a problem by reminding them to park in your driveway. The restrictions are enforced by a complaint to the police department.

Drainage Easement Repair

It has been noted by the board that more than one of the drainage paths are deteriorating. The City Engineer checked to determine if it was the city's responsibility to repair. It is home owner's responsibility to see to the repair and maintenance of the drainage easements.
